

LEPOA BEACH AND FISHING REGULATIONS

BEACH REGULATIONS

- The Beach water is not suitable for drinking. Avoid swallowing Beach water.
- Admission to the Beach may be refused to all persons having any contagious disease, infectious conditions such as colds, fever, ringworm, foot infections, skin lesions, carbuncles, boils, diarrhea, vomiting, inflamed eyes, ear discharges, or any other condition which has the appearance of being infectious. Persons with excessive sunburn, abrasions which have not healed, corn plasters, bunion pads, adhesive tape, rubber bandages, or other bandages of any kind may also be refused admittance. A person under the influence of alcohol or exhibiting erratic behavior shall not be permitted in the Beach area.
- Littering is prohibited. In addition, no food, drink, gum, or tobacco is allowed in the water. Glass containers are prohibited throughout the Beach area.
- All children who are not toilet-trained shall wear tight fitting rubber or plastic pants.
- No one should swim alone.
- Persons under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a responsible person 16 years of age or older.
- Personal contact within the Beach must be such that safety is not jeopardized.
- Diving in shallow water is not permitted.
- Caution shall be exercised in the use of diving facilities.
- Swimming is prohibited after sunset or before sunrise, or when thunder is heard or lightning is seen, including a 15-minute period after the last lightning or thunder is detected.
- No pets are permitted in Beach area.
- Feeding wildlife or other actions that encourage their presence is prohibited.
- Patrons are encouraged to protect themselves from sun exposure.

BEACH, LAKE, AND FISHING RULES

- In order to use the Beach or Lake, you must be a member in good standing (see Bylaws).
- A member of a property owners' family **MUST** accompany all guests utilizing the Lake or Beach.
- Property Owners will be responsible for the conduct of their guests and their children's guests.
- Picnicking or fires will be limited to designated areas.
- Everyone is responsible for cleaning up after him or herself; the trash can is there for that purpose and not to be used for any other purpose.
- Vehicle parking will be permitted only in designated areas.
- All children 16 years of age or younger must be accompanied by an adult.

BEACH AND FISHING REGULATIONS

- Unless accompanied by a parent, resident children must limit their guests to two (2).
- The Beach and Lake close at sunset.
- There will be **NO ROUGH PLAY OR TURNING OVER OF THE RAFT.**
- Please be considerate in your use of the Beach and equipment, do not monopolize.
- **NO BOATS OR FISHING IS ALLOWED IN THE SWIMMING AREA.**
- The use of gasoline powered motors is prohibited.
- The operation of remote controlled hobby craft is prohibited.
- Each member may have one boat kept on the Boat Launch area. The member, at the direction of the Lake Committee, must put their lot number on the outside of their boat.
- If a boat is determined to be unsafe by the Lake Committee, the boat owner will be notified and will be required to remove the boat from the Boat Launch area.
- If a boat in the Boat Launch area is determined to be abandoned by the Lake Committee, the Lake Committee will dispose of the abandoned boat.
- Each boat in the Boat Launch area MUST BE LOCKED and must be within the area of the railroad timbers.
- No boat or watercraft of any kind may be kept overnight on the lawn or sand.
- All openings cut into the ice for purposes of ice fishing shall conform to the specified legal size of 12" in diameter. These holes must be marked permanently by a bright red flag, not less than 10" square, mounted on top of a metal rod extending 3 to 5 feet above the surface of the ice.
- Never use live minnows for bait.
- Never throw back sunfish.
- This is a catch and release lake.
- Non-residents are not allowed to use our Beach or fish in our lake. If in doubt, question people as to where they live.
- The operation of motorized all terrain vehicles and snowmobiles are prohibited within Lakeland Estates boundaries.
